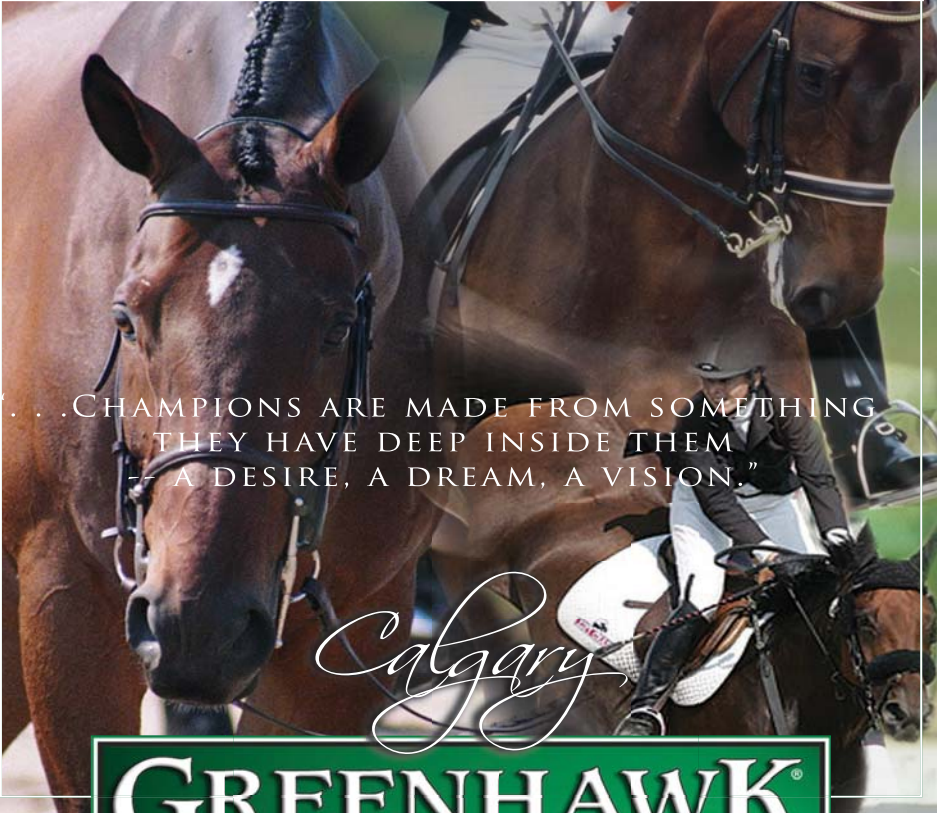

It is understood that under no circumstances shall Rocky Mountain Show Jumping, Anderson Ranch, Caroline Jones not the owner, management, Tournament committee, not any of its staff or agents be liable for any loss, damages, claims or costs as a result of Rocky Mountain show Jumping, Anderson Ranch, Caroline Jones, not the owners, Management, tournament committee, not any of its staff or agents, negligence, and that you agree to indemnify and save harmless Rocky Mountain Show Jumping, Anderson Ranch, Caroline Jones nor the owners, management, tournament committee, not any of its staff or agents from and against any and all liability arising out of any such loss, damages, claims or costs.

Prizes

Ribbons will be awarded to eighth place in all classes. Championships & Reserve Championships will be awarded at the completion of both the Hunter & Jumper Tournament series, and will be awarded based on the accumulated points over the three tournaments.

Prize Money

Prize Money will be a combination of cash & Rocky Mountain Horseshoe Rewards divided as follows:

Rules and Regulations

The management committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any errors or make alterations that may be necessary in the prize list. The management committee reserves the right to remove any groom, trainer, owner, manager, or rider from the tournament without compensation. Any trainer, owner, manager, or rider from the tournament without compensation. Any acts of discourtesy, or disobedience to the judges or officials by the owner, rider, manager, trainer or groom shall disqualify them from further competition in the tournament and the owner shall forfeit all fees. Inhumane treatment of a horse including polling, parring, or other abuse will not be tolerated. Violation of this rule will result in immediate disqualification, and forfeiture of the fees. In the case of disqualification, the horse winning the succeeding prize shall receive the prize of the disqualified horse and the other prizes will be adjusted accordingly. Courses will be posted in the hitching ring one half hour prior to the start of each class. An approved hard hat with a properly secured and fastened harness is compulsory for all competitors while riding over fences anywhere on the tournament grounds. Horses shall be allowed to compete "Hors Concours" with permission from the management. Anyone exhibiting dangerous or unsportsmanlike behavior may, at the discretion of the tournament committee, be expelled from the grounds and forfeit fees.

Entry Procedure:

Entries must be in the hands of the show secretary by the closing date listed on entry forms. Entry forms must be accompanied by a cheque, money order or credit card number to cover all entry fees, office fees, stabling fees and any other applicable fees. N.S.F. cheques will result in an additional \$40 service fee.

Competitors are responsible for their own errors or those of their agents in preparation of their entry forms. Juniors must have a parent or guardian sign their entry form.

Entries received after the closing date will be subject to a \$50 late fee.

The Winter Training Series management reserves the right to limit entries in any division and to refuse or decline any entry without being liable for compensation or damages.

PLEASE CHECK THE ENTRY FORMS FOR THE CLOSING DATES

Refunds

Exhibitors cancelling their entries before the closing date will be issued a refund in full. After the closing date of entries but prior to the start of the tournament, shall, upon presentation of a valid veterinarian certificate, forfeit their stall and office fees, all other fees will be refunded. Non veterinarian scratches will not be refunded after the closing date.

Tack

Refer to Article G203 in EC Rules 201. Boots and polo wraps shall be allowed in Hunter classes.

Management

The series management reserves the right to limit entries in any division and to refuse or decline any entry without being liable for compensation or damages. Ties for championships will be decided by a coin toss.

Memberships

All riders and owners must be a Bronze level member of Equine Canada or higher. Bronze memberships will sold at the show @\$45.00 or Temporary Sport Licence can be purchased for \$55.

All entries must be CEDL members.

Substitutions

Will be Charged a \$25 Administration Fee.

Stabling

Stabling will be available from 7:00am on the first day of the series until one hour after the completion of the last class of the series. Stall bay be bedded with shaving only! Bedding will be supplied. Stabling will be allotted according to distance traveled. Out of town horses will have absolute priority. Stabling is limited. Day stalls will be available at the rate of \$50 per day only if available. Horses coming in the night before will be charged a \$10 Fee and stalls will not be available before 6pm.

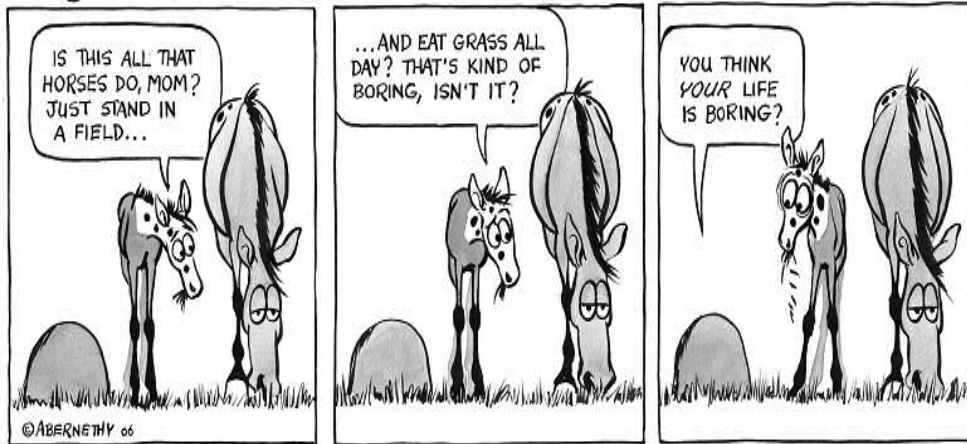
No horse will be placed in an unassigned stall without approval of the management.

EQUINE CANADA STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE

EQUINE Canada (EC), the National Equestrian Federation of Canada supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competition under its jurisdiction.

EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration
In all activities:
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- Ensuring that owner's, trainers and exhibitors or their agents use responsible care in handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses place in their care for any purpose;
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure;
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices;
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions;
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

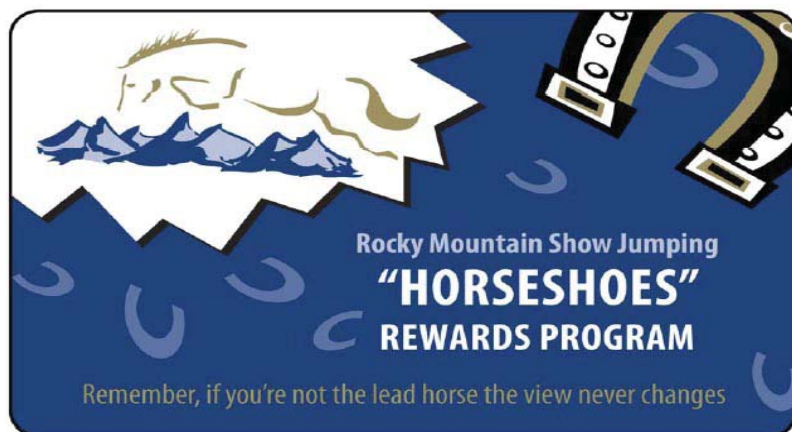

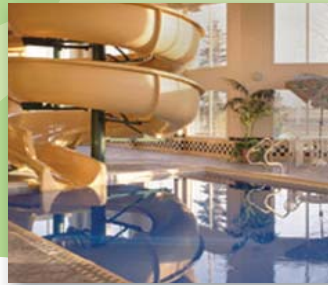
