◆RULES AND REGULATIONS◆

The RMSJ Fall Classic Horse Show will be run under Equine Canada Rules and is a Gold Level Horse Show.

MANAGEMENT - Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any given classes that does not fill to their satisfaction. All exhibitors in cancelled classes will be notified by telephone (providing telephone number is on entry form) and any entry fees returned. No notification will be given for combined classes. Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges or class order to facilitate time schedule and condition, and the right to start the first class of any session 30 minutes earlier than the scheduled time if entries warrant.

ENTRIES – Entries must be signed by the owner or authorized agent. **Entry Fees must accompany all entries. Post-dated cheques will be considered as post entries.**

A parent or legal guardian must sign the entry for a junior exhibitor and the junior's birth date must be given. **Junior's age:** Under 18 as of January 1, 2008. Check at the Horse Show Office for "A", "B", & "C" ages.

Entries in Equitation classes must be made in the name of the rider. Numbers will be assigned to horses. Equitation riders not riding their own horses must enter on a separate entry form and receive an equitation number. An open cheque must be given to the show office before numbers will be given out.

PASSPORTS & MEMBERSHIPS – Passports and current EQUINE CANADA GOLD membership is required for Horse/riders entered in the competition. If a passport is not presented then a temporary horse registration must be purchased at the show (\$35).

REFUNDS

Cancellation Before Closing Date: Entries will be refunded in full.
Cancellation after closing Date but Before the start of Show: Stall fees will not be refunded. Upon presentation of a Vets Slip to the show office, the entry fees, exhibitor fees, and warm up fees will be refunded, minus an office fee of \$30 or 15% fee whichever is greater. Stall Fee, nomination and exhibitor fees will not be refunded.
Cancellation after the show starts: Upon presentation of a Vets Slip to the show office, class fees for the classes that have not been shown in will be refunded minus a \$30 or 15% fee whichever is greater. Stall Fee, Nomination and exhibitor fees will not be refunded.

POST ENTRIES

1. Entries received after the closing date for the show will pay a penalty of \$25.
2. Horses showing in a class without being entered will pay DOUBLE the class fee.

CHANGES – There will be NO office charge per add/scratch sheet if done the day before the competition starts for horses already entered prior to closing date. An open cheque must be presented to the Horse Show Secretary before any add/scratch forms can be processed. All changes must be made no later than one-half hour after the last class of the day. Late and same day changes will be charged \$10.00 per class. Same Day Scratches will not be refunded.

CHEQUES – There will be a \$30 service charge on all NSF cheques. POST DATED CHEQUES – will be treated as LATE entries.

COMBINED CLASSES & DIVISIONS - Any class or division that does not have at least four entries 12 hours before the first class is scheduled (unless otherwise specified) will be combined or cancelled.

ENTERED AND DID NOT COMPETE - Any exhibitor who does not compete in a class(es) in which the exhibitor is officially entered, and does not scratch according to the Scratch Procedures outlined above, will be billed for the class(es). You MUST do your paperwork in the Show office in order to avoid this penalty.

STABLING – Stabling will not be available before September 9th at 9:00 am Stabling for just one week is \$175. Day stalls will be sold for \$50 a day.

SHAVINGS & FEED

Shavings & Feed will be available through the horse show office.

HAUL-IN'S – Trailing in each day is allowed.

PROTESTS - Should any question or disputes arise not provided for in the rulebook it shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision will be final.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR – Must be worn at all national Equine Canada sanctioned competitions. All competitors' must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted on competition or event grounds. Approved headgear must meet the ASTM standards and displays the SEI seal. The British standard, BSI is also acceptable. Any rider violating this rule at any time will be immediately prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

DOGS – Dogs are allowed at the show but must be kept on a leash at all times. Loose dogs will be charged \$50 with proceeds going to the Horse Show.

PRIZE MONEY – Prize Money is awarded through 5th place (30%, 25%, 20%, 15%, 10%) unless otherwise stated.

CHAMPIONSHIP TIES – Hunter Championship Ties will be broken as per Equine Canada Rules.
