GENERAL INFORMATION

The 2009 Bow Valley Classic will be run according to the rules of Equine Canada and the management committee of the 2009 Bow Valley Classics.

All owners, riders and trainers must be EC members. They must also be AEF members or members of their provincial Equestrian Association. Foreign riders, owners and trainers must be members of their appropriate federation. This is an EC Gold Level horse show. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC rule book.

EQUINE CANADA ENTRY AGREEMENT: By entering the Bow Valley Classic Horse Shows and signing the entry blanks as owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, and on behalf of myself and my principal, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of EC and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the EC. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising and the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the EC, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered.

Competitors agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the EC and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of the competitor and horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage of benefit of the competition sport. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. Competitions waive and release rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity or to misappropriation.

INSURANCE: For insurance purposes, ALL competitors (owners, owner/agents and riders and trainers) must be fully paid and current Equine Canada and AEF members of their respective association. Temporary memberships are available for purchase in the horse show office. It is understood that those competitors and entrants not meeting the insurance requirement, will not be allowed and such competitors and entrants agree not to compete or ride at this competition. The competitor agrees it will not mount up/enter any show ring/warm up ring or allow the horse to be on the show grounds without valid insurance in place. The competitor or entrant agrees to hold Anderson Ranch, the Rocky Mountain Show Jumping organization committee and the Bow Valley Classic Horse Shows and all related parties harmless against any and all claims, actions and costs as result of any such event, and actions, or injury, damage, or events as a result of such animal.

GENERAL INFORMATION - BOW VALLEY CLASSIC'S

LIABILITY: All owners and competitors and trainers are personally responsible for damages to third person caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They they owners and competitors and trainers are **MUST** have third party insurance to provide full coverage for participation in equestrian events at the Bow Valley Classic Horse Shows and to keep all policies current and fully updated. Neither the Bow Valley Classic Horse Shows, Anderson Ranch, Rocky Mountain Show Jumping, not the organizing committee, board of directors, sponsors, volunteers nor contractors shall be in any way liable for any accident, injury, death, damage, loss or for any other matter that my happen, from any causes or circumstances whatsoever to competitors, exhibitors, or members of their family or their agents, or to any one on Anderson Ranch and the Bow Valley Classic Horse Shows or to any animal or article exhibited or to any property brought on to the Anderson Ranch property and to the Bow Valley Classic Horse Show grounds, or for any other loss, claim, matter, circumstance or event whatsoever in connection with or arising out of or attributable to the Bow Valley Classic Horse Shows or any journey to and from the Bow Valley Classic Horse Shows.

GOLF CARTS: Private Golf Carts and other motorized/electric modes of personal transport shall be used at the sole risk and operated in responsible manner.



GENERAL INFORMATION - BOW VALLEY CLASSIC'S

MANAGEMENT: The management reserves the right to cancel or combine any given class that does not fill to their satisfaction. No notification will be given to combined classes. The show is open to all; however the Bow Valley Classic Tournament Committee and management reserve the right to refuse any entry. Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges or class order to facilitate time schedule and condition, and the right to start the first class of any section 30 minutes earlier than the scheduled time if entries warrant.

ENTRY PROCEDURE:

1. All entries must be accompanied with payment in full or a credit card number in order to be accepted.
2. Numbers will not be issued without an open cheque or a credit card number to cover the balance of the entries.
3. American exhibitors wishing to pay by cheque drawn in US funds will be charged the going rate on the date of the cheque. US exhibitors wishing to pay in Canadian Funds must pay by bank draft.
4. All entries received after the closing date will be charged a \$50 late fee.
5. Entries received after the show has started will pay a late fee of \$100.
6. NSF cheques will result in an additional \$35 service fee. Post dated cheques will be considered as a post entry.
7. A junior is a rider under the age of 18 as of January 1st, 2009. Juniors date of birth must be given on the entry form.

POST ENTRIES:

1. Entries received after the closing date, April 30th, 2009, will pay a penalty of \$50
2. New entries made after the show starts will pay a penalty of \$100.
3. Horses shown in a class without being entered will pay double the class fee.

GENERAL INFORMATION - BOW VALLEY CLASSIC

REFUNDS:

Cancellation Before the Closing Date: entries will be refunded in full.

Cancellation after Closing date but before the Start of the Tournament: Stall fees will not be refunded. Upon presentation of a Vets certificate to the entry secretary, the entry fees, exhibitor fees, and warm up fees will be refunded minus an office fee of \$30 or 15% whichever is greater.

Cancellation After the Show Starts: Upon presentation of a Vets certificate to the entry secretary, class fees for the classes that have not been shown in, will be refunded minus a \$30 office fee, or 15% fee, whichever is greater. Stall Fee, nomination and exhibitor fees will not be refunded.

SUBSTITUTIONS: With a veterinarian's certificate a new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse. There will be a \$25 substitution fee and all monies will be transferred to the new entry.

CHANGES: There will be no office charge per add/scratch sheet if done the day before the competition starts for horses already entered prior to closing date. All adds and scratches must be made 1/2 hour after the last regular class of the day. Late and same day adds will be charged \$10 per class in the hunter ring. **SAME DAY SCRATCHES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE IN EITHER HUNTER OR JUMPER RINGS.**

ENTERED & DID NOT COMPETE: Any exhibitor who does not compete in a class in which the exhibitor is officially entered, and does not scratch according to the scratch procedures outlined above will be billed for the classes. You **MUST** do your paperwork in the Tournament Office in order to avoid this penalty.

COMBINED CLASSES & SECTIONS: Any class or section that does not have a minimum of 4 entries 12 hours before the first class is scheduled (unless otherwise specified) will be combined.

CONFLICTS: Riders are not limited to the number of horses per class **BUT MUST ABIDE BY THIS RULE:** If a rider foresees a problem, he/she must consult a paddock manager on the grounds. The paddock manager's decision will be final. Under no circumstances will a rider be permitted to show more than 2 horses in a row at the end of a class. In this event, all horses must be in the vicinity of the ring and the rider will be given 5 minutes to warm-up and enter the ring with each horse. If the horses are not in the warm-up area the judge is instructed to pin the class.

BARN BILLS & TRAINER SPLITS: Trainers requiring barn bills should set them up at the beginning of the tournament with an open cheque or a credit card number. Trainer splits must be done no later than Saturday of each competition.

GENERAL INFORMATION - BOW VALLEY CLASSIC'S

HUNTER SCHOOLING: Ticketed schooling will be available over a posted course. Heights will be at specific times, please refer to the schedule. Tickets can be purchased at the tournament office. Hunter Schooling Tickets: \$10/round.

EQUITATION: Entries for equitation classes must be made in the name of the rider. Numbers will be assigned to the horses. Equitation riders not riding their own horses must enter on a separate entry form and receive an equitation number.

ARRIVAL: Horses may not arrive before 9am on Monday May 11th, 2009.

STABLING: Stabling will be in either outside portable stalls or in permanent indoor stalls. Stabling will be allocated on a first come first serve basis. Stabling at \$200/week for premium stalls and for \$150/week for portable stalls.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: All competitors must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on competition or event grounds. All competitors must wear STM or BSI approved helmets of conservative color with safety harness correctly fastened at all times while mounted on the competition grounds. Juniors must wear headgear when jogging Article G102.

SCHOOLING: ***2009 NEW RULE*** FEI Schooling rules will be followed * Article G 201.

MEMBERSHIPS: All riders and owners (for insurance purposes) must have be a member in good standing with the Alberta Equestrian Federation and Equine Canada. Numbers will not be issued to anyone not in good standing. All riders must be Alberta Show Jumping Association members.

PASSPORTS: Passports and current Equine Canada Gold Lever memberships are required. If a passport is not presented then a temporary horse registration must be purchased at each show at a cost of \$35. Competitors and owners that do not have a gold level membership will be charged \$15 for an upgrade membership.

SHAVINGS & FEED: A pre order of 5 bags of shavings will be in your stall upon arrival at \$37.50. Additional shavings can be purchased in the tournament office at \$8.00/bag and hay at \$10.00/bale.

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash at all times, dogs caught off leash will be charged a \$50 penalty at the Show Office.

PROTESTS: Should any question or disputes arise not provided for in the rule book it shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision will be final.

GENERAL INFORMATION - BOW VALLEY CLASSIC

PRIZE MONEY: Prize money is awarded through 6th place unless otherwise stated. Prize money will be divided as follows:

1st - 30% • 2nd - 25% • 3rd - 15% • 4th - 12% • 5th - 10% • 6th - 8%

Awards, Champion and Reserve Ribbons will be presented to the Champion and Reserve Champions of each division.

EQUINE Canada (EC), the National Equestrian Federation of Canada supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competition under its jurisdiction.

EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration
 - In all activities:
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- Ensuring that owner's, trainers and exhibitors or their agents use responsible care in handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses place in their care for any purpose;
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure;
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices;
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions;
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.



The Bow Valley Classic competitions are a sanctioned Gold competition member of Equine Canada, 2685 Queensview Dr., Suite 100, Ottawa, Ontario, K2B 8K2 and is governed by the rules of Equine Canada.

HUNTER RULES & REGULATIONS

*****NEW HUNTER RULES 2009:** *No Horses or Ponies will be allowed to show 'Hors Concours' in hunter/equitation, medal classes or divisions. A second cumulative refusal, run out or bolting on course results in elimination.****

LOW HUNTERS: Open to all Horses and Ponies.

SCHOOLING HUNTER: Open to all Horses and Ponies.

PRE-GREEN HUNTER: Open to all Horses that have not competed in a Hunter, Equitation or Jumper at regular member shows of EC or USA Equestrian. Horses may compete as Pre Green for 2 consecutive years.

First Year: Fences to 3'0" (0.90m)

Second Year: Fences to 3'3" (1.00m)

COMBINED WORKING HUNTER: Open to First year, Second year and Regular Horses, heights to be adjusted accordingly. Level of horse is to be stated on the entry form.

First Year: Fences to 3'6" (1.10m)

Second Year: Fences to 3'9" (1.15m)

Regular: Fences to 4'0" (1.20m)

JUNIOR/AMATEUR WORKING HUNTER: Fences to 3'6" (1.10m)

Open to all junior and amateur riders. Riders may not cross enter into Children's Hunter or Adult Hunter divisions.

MODIFIED JUNIOR/AMATEUR HUNTER: Open to all junior and amateur riders. Fences to 3'3" (1.00m)

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER: Fences to 3'0" (0.90m)

Open to all horses ridden by an Adult Amateur rider. Riders may not cross enter into any class with hunter fences over 3'3" (1.00m) or Jumper classes over 3'9" (1.15m).

CHILDREN'S HUNTER: Fences to 3'0" (0.90m)

Open to all junior riders who have not competed in classes higher than 3'3" (1.00m)

MODIFIED CHILD/ADULT HUNTER: Fences to 2'9" (0.85m)

Open to all junior/adult riders. No cross entry into any Hunter Classes over 3'0" (0.90m) or Jumper classes over 3'3"

PONY WORKING HUNTER: Open to all ponies ridden by junior riders as per EC rules. No pony can cross enter with Children's Hunter Divisions. Riders may cross enter on a different horse. Junior A riders can not ride a small or medium pony.

Small ponies (12.2 hands and under): Fences to 2'3"

Medium ponies (over 12.2 hands - 13.2 hands): Fences to 2'6"

Large ponies (over 13.2 hands -14.2 hands): Fences to 2'9"

HUNTER RULES AND REGULATIONS

DEVELOPING RIDER X-RAIL: Open to developing riders only.

DEVELOPING RIDER 2'0": Open to all horses and ponies, only developing riders will collect points. Developing riders may not cross enter with any other division with jumps over 2'3"

DEVELOPING RIDER 2'3": Open to all horses and ponies, only developing riders will collect points. Developing riders may not cross enter with any other division with jumps over 2'6"

PRE CHILD/ADULT HUNTER 2'6": Open to all horses and ponies, only developing riders will collect points. Developing riders may not cross enter with any division with jumps over 2'9".

SHORT STIRRUP PONY HUNTER 2'3": Open to junior riders only. This division is designed for the beginner rider. Heights and distances will not be changed for pony sizes.

BABY GREEN HUNTER 2'6": Open to all horses and ponies in their first year of showing.

GLEN MCILVRIDE MEMORIAL HUNTER CLASSIC: See Equitation & Medal spec's for details.

PRIZE MONEY:

\$100 for all regular Hunter Over Fences classes unless otherwise stated.

\$150 for all Hunter Stake Classes unless otherwise stated.

No prize money is awarded for under saddle classes or equitation classes.

CHAMPIONSHIPS: To be eligible for division champion and Reserve Champion you must enter by division. All hunter divisions will be awarded a Champion and Reserve Champion.

JUMPER RULES & REGULATIONS

Jumpers will be scored under Alternate Table A (FEI Article 238). Ties for 1st place will jump off. In ties other than 1st place, money will be added together and divided equally: riders will toss a coin for ribbons. A computer draw is established daily for certain jumper classes. Horses may be required to jump in posted order. Exhibitors riding more than one horse in any class if not listed on the entry form (i.e. Catch riding) must inform the show Office on hour before the class goes so that their rides may be spaced. At no time will the gate be held for more than one minute due to riders or trainer conflict. Jump-off to be ridden over a shortened course. Some fences may be raised by 3". Jumper Divisions may include - Time First, Power & Speed and Speed.

NOMINATED RINGS: Horses entered in the Grand Prix Ring pay a nomination fee of \$150. Horses entered Jumper II will pay a nomination fee of \$50. Jumper nomination fees are non-refundable. Nomination fees allow jumpers to move from classes and / or divisions without an add/scratch fee.

LATE JUMPER NOMINATION FEE: Horses not nominated by the closing date of entries for the show must pay a nomination fee of \$225 in the Grand Prix Ring and \$75 in Jumper II.

JUMPER NOMINATION FEE REFUND POLICY: Jumper nomination fee refund schedule will be as follows; before the start of the show of entries - 100%, after the closing date, but before the start of the show - 50%, after the show starts there is no refund.

JUMPER CHANGES: Jumper changes must be made 1/2 hour after the last regular class. SAME DAY SCRATCHES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.

FOOTING: All jumper classes will go on grass.

SCHOOLING: Clear rounds in Jumper II must be entered on entry form.

PRIZE MONEY: Prize Money will be divided as listed in the general information unless otherwise stated. There will be no prize money in any clear round classes.

*** A Horse / Rider Jr / Am / Non Pro combination is permitted unlimited upward movement, but downward movement is restricted to only one level. These movements are based on the level of the first class in which they competed.***
